Thank you for expressing an interest in studying at The Bible Institute of South Africa.

We offer a Bachelor of Theology (BTh) through Distance Learning. To qualify you will need to have a matric (Grade 12) with exemption or be 45 years or older to qualify for a mature age exemption. We are only able to accept a percentage for those that qualify for a mature age exemption. Special conditions may apply to those over 23 years of age and that have matriculated under the old HG/SG system (prospective students must have passed 2 HG subjects, one of which must be a language, and 3 SG subjects in order to enter a degree programme). The registrar may be contacted to discuss eligibility before submitting an application. If you have a foreign school leaving qualification you will need to have it assessed by the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) – 0860 111 673 / customer care@saqa.org.za

To apply for the BTh you will need to submit:

- completed application form
- please ensure that the referee section is completed
- certified copy of your ID / Passport
- certified copy of your matric certificate (or equivalent)
- certified copies of any other studies you may have done (please submit transcripts of these studies)
- 1 passport sized photograph
- R400.00 application fee (non-refundable)
